We witness it in the schools, counselors and parents who selflessly assist hundreds of people a year.


We witness it in our volunteers, our board members and the communities we have the privilege to work with.

On behalf of our family, thank you for all you do.



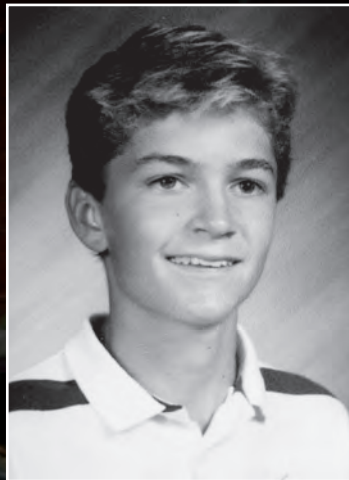
The LaViolette's



After Brian was lost in a swimming accident at the age of 15, the Brian LaViolette Scholarship Foundation was established by awarding one scholarship in Brian's name at his high school in DePere, Wisconsin. Since then, the Foundation has expanded worldwide presenting scholarships from New York to Hawaii and touching some across the globe in several foreign countries.

Some of the scholarships awarded have been in Brian's memory, some in honor of those close to him and some pay tribute to heroes of the past. Nearly 70% of the scholarships awarded each year honor others, allowing their spirit to live on.

By providing yearly scholarships to today's students, our mission is to honor hard work and community service, offer inspiration and share the belief that "The Journey is the Reward."

THE BRIAN LAVIOLETTE SCHOLARSHIP

With *Partners in Education's* guidance and administration support, we created *The Brian LaViolette Scholarship*. Open to all graduating seniors in the Partners in Education Green Bay school district, this \$10,000 award goes to a high school senior who has shown exemplary achievement throughout his or her high school career.

The criteria evaluated includes academics, leadership and community involvement— aspects of life that were important to Brian while growing up and attending school. Those students chosen display a thirst for individual knowledge, but are also team players and show promise to be our future leaders.

A selection committee made up of representatives from Partners in Education, along with the LaViolette family, narrow down 17 high school seniors' applications. One student is chosen by selected staff from each high school to apply and five finalists are chosen to go through the interview process.



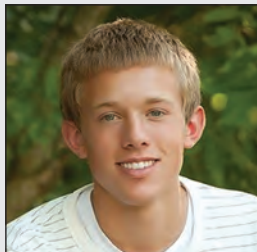

INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP OF HONOR – POLAND

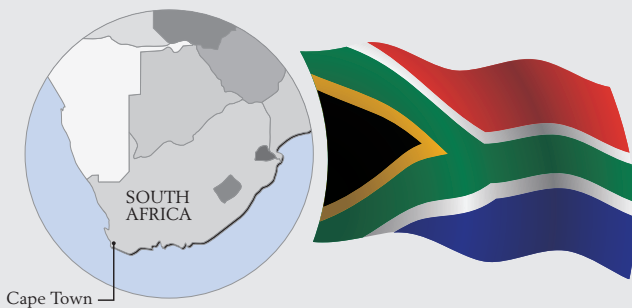

INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP OF HONOR – SOUTH AFRICA



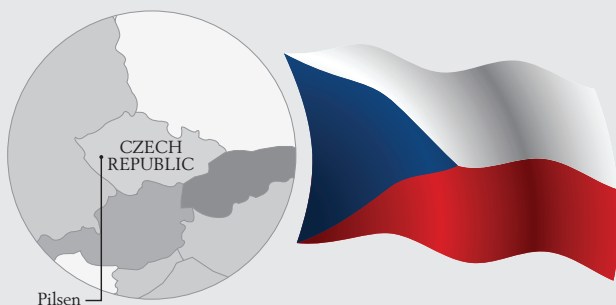

- **PURPLE RIBBON** is symbolic of the Purple Heart Medal and indicates sacrifice
- **FIVE STARS** represent the five branches of our Armed Forces
- **EAGLE** represents the U.S.A. and the freedom we enjoy
- **SHIELD** represents strength and protection
- **ARROWS** symbolize strength
- **OLIVE BRANCH** symbolizes peace
- **OPEN BOOK** symbolizes continuing knowledge
- **THE POLISHED HIGHLIGHTS** symbolize the shining example set by these servicemen and women and our promise to never tarnish their memory
- **THREE FIGURES AND WATER** the Foundation's original logo representing adults helping children, the LaViolette's and Brian himself
- **REVERSE SIDE** is engraved with details about those who have served and are being honored with this award. Those details are surrounded by a wreath symbolizing honor and achievement

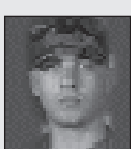

- Parents reevaluating their roles and responsibilities
- Individuals rekindling their family relationships
- Business people reconsidering their priorities
- Youth reviewing Brian's foundations for living

This experience for us has not been life affecting—it has been life changing.

Like an early morning wake-up call, we are startled out of a somber, placid existence into a new and different world. The message is quite clear—who are we, where do we want to go, and how best to get there. Similar to your bright, young son and brother who selected the best principles, philosophies, and guideposts as his foundation and pathway through life. We are reminded that the *journey is the reward* and the trip is best when done together.

MORE ABOUT BRIAN

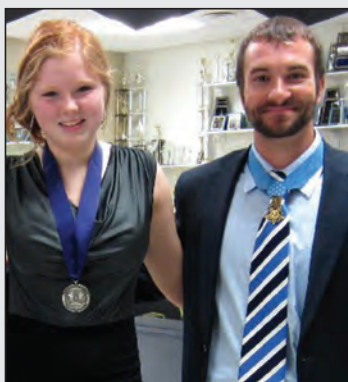
